Migrants' Action plan in a nutshell : what is it ?



The strategy of the Social Services Center of Paris (CASVP) to address the multiple challenges of welcoming and integrating the persons with a migratory background. It has been developed in strong coherence with the City of Paris Global strategy to welcome refugees.



The tool of the CASVP, strongly committed to support the emergency operations to welcome refugees in Paris since 2015, to find a right balance between the immediate needs assistance to persons with a migratory background and the longer-term approach to integration



The result of a participatory and collective approach : workshops with CASVP staff and partners since 2018

Sensitize, train and give tools to the professionals of the CASVP


Adapt our establishments and programs
